School Action Scenario

Read the following scenario concerning a potential situation at your school. Then, work together to answer the reflection questions that follow. Answer each of those questions with at least two academic sentence responses. Make sure that you record the responses on your own document. You may be called upon to share your group's thoughts during the whole-class discussion.

Scenario:

You are absolutely sick of the annoying electronics policy at your school. You think students should be allowed to use phones in class as long as it does not disrupt the learning process. You and other students are ready to take action and let the administrators know that this policy needs to change.

Reflection Questions:

- 1. What medium/s (method/s) would you use to get the administrator's attention? What would your tone be (angry, grateful, professional)? Why?
- 2. Assume the administrators are willing to listen to your point of view. What evidence would you use to back up your position on this issue?
- 3. They want details of your proposal. Would ALL students (K-8) get this privilege? Will your proposal create problems with some of the students at school?
